Play It Safe This Holiday

The holiday season is a great time to throw a party. There is no time like the present to invite family and friends over, and to dress up the house with fancy holiday decorations. You can keep your guests and home safe during the holidays by becoming a Safety Detective like P.I. Plug. Seek out electrical and fire hazards and ask an adult to fix them.



Never play with electrical decorations, lights, cords, or outlets.

Matches and candles should only be handled by adults. Blow candles out when you leave the room or go to sleep.

Don't overload outlets with too many appliances or decorations. If the outlet looks too crowded with cords, ask an adult for help.

Make sure cords aren't left where people could trip over them.

Make sure cords are not pinched or damaged by windows, doors, or furniture.

Test smoke alarms once a month, and replace batteries at least once a year.

Never yank on the cord to unplug something. Hold on to the plug itself.

Don't leave space heaters unattended.

An adult should be around if something is cooking. Keep the stove and cooking area clear of anything flammable, such as towels or pot holders.
